A physical description is to take I-25 northbound out of Santa Fe to the El Dorado/Clines Corners Exit. After exiting the Interstate, turn left and cross under the interstate north roughly ½ mile until the road ends at the Old Las Vegas Highway. Turn left, drive for roughly 100 yards, then turn right onto Ellis Ranch Road (county rd 46). After roughly ¾ mile, turn right onto San Sebastian Road (county rd 110). After another roughly ¾ mile, look for a sign or balloons at Rick's driveway on the right. The drive goes down through a bottom and back up to his house. Rick has promised to put something out to mark his driveway to make it easy to find so we can avoid the usual task of driving back and forth on San Sebastian looking for his driveway.
